- -An advocate (v.4): Mordecai represents the help of the Holy Spirit
- -Killing self: No compromise is made with the execution of the old self.
- -Beyond the capitol: Taking victory outside to your realm of influence.
- -Superior Motivation: Victory, not for my own self-advancement, but for God's glory.
- 3. With the institution of the Purim celebration, God allowed the Jewish people to memorialize their experience of near extermination and allow their losses to bless them. How have you allowed your losses to bless you?
